It was a great start to the New Year, as some of our SJIS students represented our school at district and state levels in recent sporting events.

The MSSWP KL and MSSM events started from the 22<sup>nd</sup> of January, and ended on the 12<sup>th</sup> of February, 2016. The students took part in competitions for five different sports, which included Basketball, Cross Country Run, Badminton, Table Tennis and Swimming.


The MSSWP Basketball tournament took place at SMK Sek 5, Wangsa Maju KL, from the 26<sup>th</sup> of January to the 4<sup>th</sup> of February. Twelve students participated in the under 18 MSSWP competition in Keramat Zone. The team qualified for the quarter finals, and SJIS obtained 5<sup>th</sup> place in KL. Out of the five matches played, the SJIS basketball team won 2 matches.

Our next event was the Cross Country Run which was held on the 27<sup>th</sup> of January, at Taman Tasik Park, Titiwangsa, KL. This time, 20 students took part in this event. Chong Xian Hao won second place for the boys - under 15 event, while Varrhynshar Sebastian was ranked 40 for the boys – under 18 event. As for the girls, Emily Yeap ranked 30 for the girls- under 18 event.



The Badminton MSSWP competition in Keramat Zone took place from the 2<sup>nd</sup> to the 5<sup>th</sup> of February 2016 at JJ court, Jalan Genting Klang, KL. 21 students participated in this event for the boys, in both the singles and doubles categories. A few of the participants qualified for representing district level. Tan Lee Quan and Chew Jian Sheng each won a bronze medal, winning 3<sup>rd</sup> place for the boys – under 15 singles competition. For the boys under 15 – doubles competition, the brothers, Richard Siew and Wilson Siew, each received a gold medal which they deserve as they won first place. Second place goes to the talented twins, Kuan Jin Han and Kuan Jin Hao as they won a silver medal for the boys doubles under 15 categories.

The MSSM Swimming competition in KL district level was held from 2<sup>nd</sup> February to the 5<sup>th</sup> of February 2016 at Komplek Renang DBKL, Cheras. Out of the 8 students who participated in this event, three students made SJIS proud by bringing accolades. Those students were Natalie Cheong Kah Man from year 9-1 by winning 4<sup>th</sup> place for 100m back stroke, Low Kenji who won 3 gold and 5 silver medals, and Chew Chee Ming (Anson) who won 3 gold, 3 silver and 1 bronze medal and breaking the records for 400m and 200m Individual Medley.



The final event that took place from 2<sup>nd</sup> February to 5<sup>th</sup> February 2016 was the MSSM Table Tennis Tournament in KL district level. The male participants competed at Pusat Activiti Taman Seri Rampai and the girls competed at Dewan Sultan Sulaiman, KL. Six students participated in this event and Michael Ryan Wang Hong Jian won 3<sup>rd</sup> place in Zone Keramat- KL for the under 15 singles competition.
